How inscrutable are your thoughts, O God...Ps 139:17

Father Aubin Coly, the younger brother of Father Remy Coly, MSC, has died suddenly. Please keep Fr. Coly and his family in your prayers, and pray for the repose of the soul of Father Aubin Coly.

I have just learned with sadness, pain, and along with a bruised heart the unexpected death of my younger brother Father Aubin Coly. Father Aubin is the youngest member of our family. He comes right after me. We were very close even if we were not twins. He was just 48 years old. He was a religious in the Congregation of the Piarist Fathers. **He was ordained a priest on June 30, 2008.** After his ordination, he served as a Pastor in a parish called St. Mary Mother of God, before the Lord called him to Himself.

It was around 1:00 p.m. that I received a phone call from a cousin who wanted to know if I had any news about Father Aubin because he had just learned that he was seriously ill. Upon his arrival by bus, at his parish no doubt that he was not feeling well, he went to a pharmacy and on the way, he fell. He was rescued and after a few minutes in the hospital, the doctor pronounced him dead. At the moment his Provincial Superior is going to meet with the Bishop of the diocese where my brother worked and at the end of this meeting a decision will be taken on the place and date of the funeral.
