PASTOR'S CORNER:

Our picture of God is influenced to some extent by our ordinary way of looking at things and that is why, as we listen to this gospel, we are tempted to react and share the grumble of the workers who have labored since early morning. In human terms, it seems a bit unfair that after slaving all day in the hot sun they got the same pay for their efforts as those who were taken on at the eleventh hour. If we get too uptight about the injustice situation, we miss the point of the story.

The parable is not dealing with equal rights. Its main thrust is to show the generosity of God in opening the doors of heaven to Gentiles and sinners on equal footing with the Jews. For the Jews, they expected special treatment because they are the chosen people.

Unfortunately, this selfish and attitude towards the salvation of sinners is not confined to the Jews only. In our every day to day life, we find this kind of attitude in ourselves. Our challenge is that we don't take generosity for granted. Entry into heaven makes no difference because it is given to those who do the will of the Father.

Before the almighty, we all stand like beggars and can never boast that we have earned our salvation. Today we commemorate and remember all catechists of our parish. May the good Lord continue their work in teaching our children about God
